### **CARLETON A. FRIDAY SCHOLARSHIPS KENNETH G. WECKEL SCHOLARSHIPS**

Each scholarship awards up to three \$1,500.00 scholarships (total of up to six scholarships) to deserving undergraduate students who are majoring in agriculture or food science within the University of Wisconsin system (currently Madison, Platteville and River Falls campuses)

Interested students must assemble and present all of the following information (see application form for specific information required) to be viewed by the MWFPA Human Resources Committee between February and June of the current year.

1. One completed application form will consider you for both scholarships (applications are available in the months of February, March, April and May of each year through your guidance office, department office, the MWFPA office or on our website at [www.mwfpa.org](http://www.mwfpa.org))
2. Grade point average (verified by providing a complete transcript)
3. Letter of recommendation from advisor or other faculty member.
4. Letter of interest from the student (not to exceed 4 pages)
5. Letter of recommendation from past or present employer(s)
6. Indication of need for financial assistance. (listed on the application form)
7. Summer and/or permanent address and phone number.

**Incomplete applications and applications received/post marked after the deadline stated on the applications will not be considered.**
